Prior to Greater Good Hope, he served as Executive Pastor of Christian Education at Concord Church in Dallas, TX under the late Dr. E. K. Bailey.

Leroy is a graduate of the University of Kansas (B.S.) and Dallas Theological Seminary (Th.M.). Leroy is currently pursuing a Ph.D. in preaching at Anderson University Clump Divinity School. Leroy also completed post-graduate studies in preaching at Oxford University (Regents Park College). He is a licensed and ordained minister of the gospel.
